ROCK THE BIKE – BEYOND FOOD ACTIVITY

Step process of the activity

1. Select one Juice from the menu (2 juice options)
2. Pick up the pre-cut fruits and/or vegetables
3. Pedal the bike
 1. Students have 30 seconds to pedal their own juice
 2. Optional: Polaroid photos can be taken during the activity
4. Staff transfer the fresh mixed juice into a juice cup/sport bottle
5. Enjoy the freshly blended juice

Items	Details
Canteen refurbishing	Acoustic studies done in 2016 Project postponed to the whole renovation of the canteen space
Renovation of Délimarché	Délimarché space to be renovated (see next slide)
Dishwashing area	Plan to renew the flooring and put a waste management process in place
Dishwasher	Plan to acquire a new dishwasher: trays are currently wet and plates cleanliness can be improved
Minor paint jobs	Plan to make the catering space neater

It is noted that the new design will be lower and will provide more fridge space. Also, maintenance on tables will be done, in the dining room.

4. Q&A:

- a. **Ms. Kayser: “Can the yoghurt be changed to non-sweet ones?”**
Raphaël Vetri: Following a previous request, this has been done already and the result seems satisfying, since no newer complaint has been recorded.

- b. **Mr. Tenne: “Can Délimarché open on Saturday, for DSS activities and parents?”**
Raphaël Vetri: Due to the low demand on the week-end, Délimarché remains only open for special events, announced in advance.

- c. **Ms. Ohnesorge: “There is visibly less sugar-intense products at Délimarché.”**
Ms. Devilliers : “But can we provide healthier options, for instance seasonal products?”
Raphaël Vetri: Noted.

- d. **M. Stöveken: “Can we add vegetables as a side-dish?”**
Raphaël Vetri: It is possible.

- e. **Ms. Benoît: “Can we top up cards thanks to WeChat or other payment methods?”**
Raphaël Vetri: Yes. WeChat and AliPay are supported. Topping up with the electronic services can take place at the salad bar only, though, where the cashier is equipped.
